The operations will be performed at the Private Gazi Hospital. The participants will be in the OR to watch the surgeries. The surgeries will be recorded by video cameras. The participants will be able to learn the fundamentals of how to do audiovisual recording as well. There will be 6 surgeries in two days. The participants will be able to scrub and interact with me in the OR. The video of the operative field will also be reflected on a monitor. The videos of a few previously operated patients will be given to the participants.

I have been using the lamb head as a teaching model for dissection for years with great success with my fellows, residents and course participants. The participants will be able to try all kinds of surgical techniques with me during lamb head dissection. The instruments will be supplied by us. You can bring your own headlight if you feel more comfortable to work with.

I am pretty sure that it will be a very fruitful learning experience for both the novice and seasoned rhinoplasty surgeons. I have been using interactive teaching techniques for a long time at the university and at the academic environment. They are best suited for small groups like this. Having organized all kinds of meetings and course, in my opinion, this is the best teaching technique as well. That is why this course is limited to 6 colleagues.

Registration fee is 4000 Euros. It can be paid on site or can preferably be transferred to the account sent to you by my secretary. Registration fee also covers the coffee breaks, lunches and dinners, but not the boarding and travel expenses. There are very nice and inexpensive hotels in Izmir. The closest ones to my office which is 5-minutes walking distance are Swissotel Izmir and M?venpick Hotel. You can make reservations by your own.
